



St. Michael Potential Storm Impacts

Coastal Flood Warning

IMPACTS:

- High water is expected to impact this evening through Sunday afternoon
- Homes near the shoreline may be surrounded by water, and there could be erosion near the old cemetery.
- Roads near the coast of St. Michael will be inundated.

What to Expect:

Water levels: 7-10 feet above the normal highest tide line

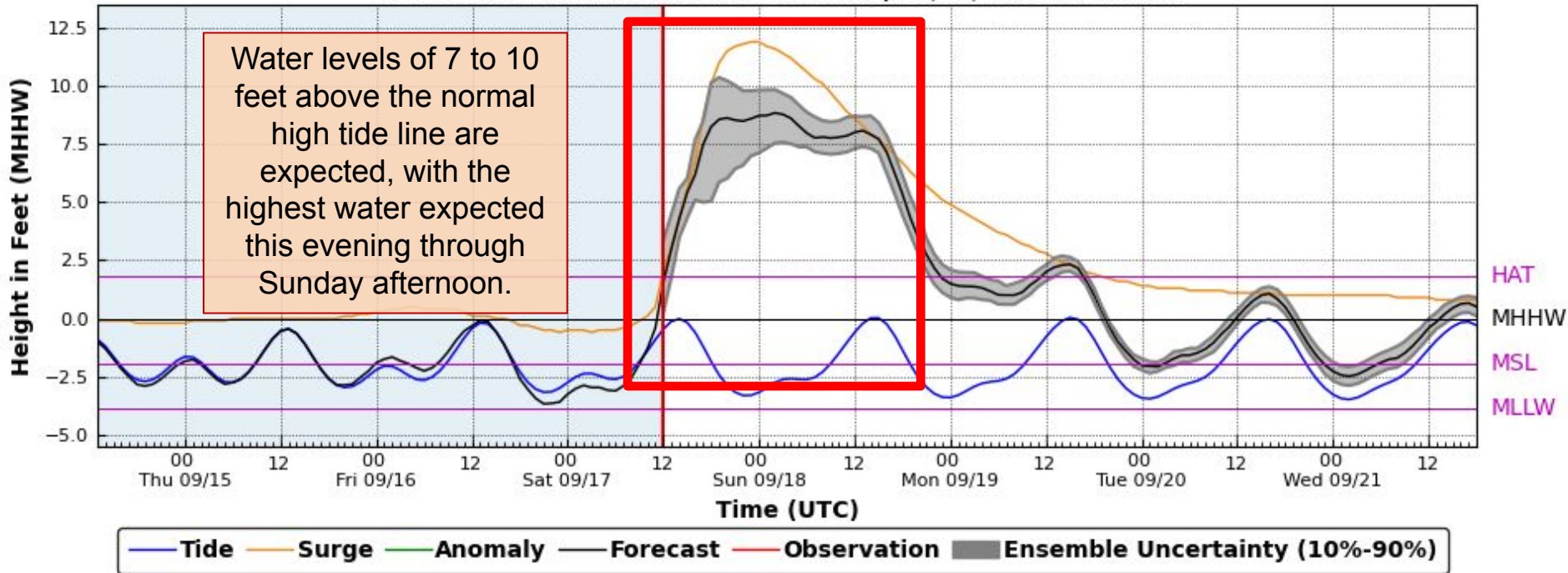
Timing: The highest water levels will occur Saturday evening.

Winds: South winds 40 to 50 mph with gusts up to 80 mph possible
